There are missing box scores for those players who are designated with an asterisk (*). We decided that, rather than give those players zero points for the missing games, we would make a best guess as to how many points they might have been likely to score. The number chosen is in line with their performances in other games and also with what we know about the leading scorer(s) in those games. For example, the highest ranked player for whom we have made a guesstimate is Ray Cronk of Bemidji (1956, 1957, 1958), #15 with an estimated 182 points. Here is how we arrived at 182 points.

- Cronk led Bemidji as a sophomore in 1956 in their first round loss to New Prague with 20 points.
- Cronk was the leading scorer in Bemidji's first round loss to Mpls. Roosevelt in 1957 with 34 points.
- Cronk is known to have led the 1958 tournament in scoring with 86 points.
- So Cronk represents a fairly extreme example in that we have to guesstimate his point total in 3 of 8 games.
- In 1956, Bemidji went on to win 2 games and the consolation title, scoring 91 and 69 points. The leading scorers in these 2 games scored 26 and 20 points, and so Cronk scored something less than that. But with a team total of 91 in the consolation semi-final, it is likely that Cronk scored somewhere around 20 points. In the consolation final, we assign him just 10 points.
- In 1957, Bemidji lost a consolation semi-final game, scoring just 56 points. The high scorer in that game scored 25 points, so Cronk scored something less than that. We assigned him 12 points.
- For the 3 missing games, we estimate that he scored 42 points. This is probably too low. This was the process for the other players marked by an asterisk. We hope to update our estimated scoring with some more research.
